



# Pronomina Latina (Pronouns)

Here you'll find the major pronouns that you'll encounter in Latin texts, all in their masculine, feminine, and neuter, singular and plural forms. Pronouns are words that stand in for nouns, in English this means words like this and that, who and which, he, she, and it. To start with focus on learning *ille*, *hic*, *qui* and *is*: these are so common that learning them off by heart is a considerable help. Once you've got that far try to expand your repetoire bit by bit, and base your learning in the real texts you'll find in the app: what follows is meant as a handy reference.

Note that with these pronouns there is some repetition across forms (like *huius*), and that there are some forms that appear twice or even three times in different roles (like *haec*) and so need to be watched.
